<b>Holy Family Grants</b>	U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens with financial need enrolled full-time in a degree program	\$200 – \$14,500	According to need after other gift aid has been applied	File FAFSA
<b>Holy Family Endowment Scholarships</b>	All enrolled students who have completed at least one semester at Holy Family	\$200 – \$7,500	Criteria established by donors as listed in the University catalog	File FAFSA and Institutional Scholarship Application
<b>Holy Family Athletic Grants</b>	All students enrolled full-time in a degree program who participate in athletic department activities	\$1,000 – \$35,590	Athletic department criteria	File FAFSA and contact Holy Family Athletic Department
<b>Federal Pell Grants</b>	U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens with financial need enrolled in a degree program	\$277 – \$5,550	Need-based according to federal formula	File FAFSA
<b>Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants (FSEOG)</b>	U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens with financial need enrolled full-time in a degree program	\$200 – \$4,000	Need based; priority given to Pell Grant recipients	File FAFSA
<b>State Grants</b>	Varies according to your state residency	\$200 – \$4,348 (PA residents)	Based on each state's requirements	File FAFSA by your state's filing deadline
<b>Outside Scholarships</b>	Holy Family encourages students to pursue outside sources of support, such as high schools, local civic groups, home congregations, and foundation or corporate grants and loans. Web sites elsewhere in this brochure and books in your local library or high school guidance counselor's office will help you locate other sources of aid.

<b>Direct Federal Stafford Subsidized Loans</b>	U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens with financial need enrolled at least half-time in a degree program	\$100 – \$5,500 Interest rate is 4.5% for undergraduate students	6 months after the student graduates or drops below half-time	File FAFSA and Direct Federal Stafford Loan Master Promissory Note
<b>Direct Federal Stafford Unsubsidized Loans</b>	U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens enrolled at least half-time in a degree program	\$100 – \$12,500 Interest rate is 6.8%	6 months after the student graduates or drops below half-time	File FAFSA and Direct Federal Stafford Loan Master Promissory Note
<b>Federal Perkins Loans</b>	U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens with financial need enrolled full-time in a degree program	\$200 – \$2,500 Interest rate is 5%	9 months after the student graduates or drops below half-time	File FAFSA; sign Perkins Promissory Note
<b>Federal Nursing Loans</b>	U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens with financial need enrolled full-time in a nursing degree program	\$200 – \$2,000 Interest rate is 5%	9 months after the student graduates or drops below half-time	File FAFSA; sign Nursing Loan Promissory Note
<b>Direct Federal Parent Loans for Undergraduate Students (PLUS)</b>	Parents of dependent students who are U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens enrolled at least half-time in a degree program	Amount not to exceed cost minus financial aid Interest rate is 7.9%	6 months after the student graduates or drops below half-time	File FAFSA and Direct Federal PLUS Loan Master Promissory Note

<b>Federal Work-Study Program (FWS)</b>	U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens with financial need enrolled full-time in a degree program	\$200 – \$1,200	Part-time on campus employment and off-campus community service	File FAFSA; additional employment forms will be required before beginning work
