

Recent Graduate Survey (2025-2026)

Holy Family University's Office of Institutional Effectiveness*

Results are based on respondents to Holy Family University's Recent Graduate Survey. The Recent Graduate Survey was administered during the Spring 2026 semester to those Holy Family University students who graduated one, three, or 5 years ago. In total, 2,120 graduates received an invitation to the Recent Graduate Survey. The following information is based on the 115 completed responses received from this population.¹

Job Placement Rates

81.2% of graduates are currently working for pay, with an average salary of \$76,950.

Percentage of Respondents that described their jobs as the following:

Position is full-time (30 hours or more per week): 96.2%

Duties on this job required the knowledge/skill/abilities gained from a college degree: 92.3%

My employer required a college degree for consideration for your employment in this job: 86.8%

Job is related to my field(s) of study: 96.2%

Job is related to my desired career path: 92.4%

10.4% of graduates are currently taking courses at a college or university.
