



The course planning and registration process at Holy Family University can be broken down into three main steps: (1) adding a course to your **timeline**, (2) **planning** your schedule, and finally, (3) **registering** for classes.

STEP 1: ADD A COURSE TO YOUR TIMELINE (SKIP THIS STEP IF IT HAS ALREADY BEEN DONE BY YOUR ADVISOR)

1a > To start, **log in to Self Service**. The landing page will prompt you to accept all agreements, confirm your emergency contact information, and verify your personal information. Be sure to check for any notifications, such as a financial hold.

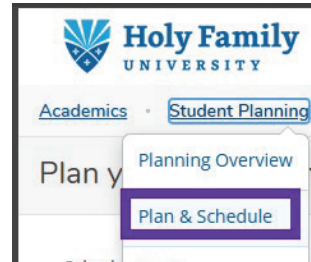

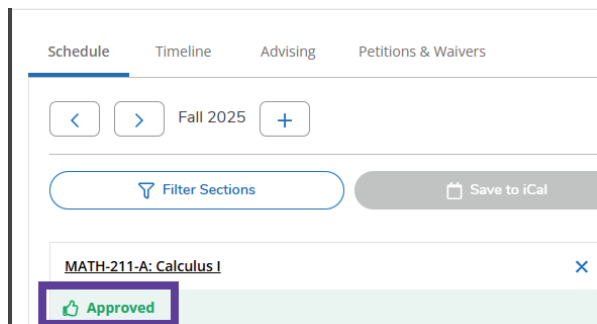

STEP 3: REGISTER FOR YOUR CLASSES

3a > Go to the **Registration Information webpage** to see when registration will open for your class level.

3b > When registration opens, go back to the **Plan & Schedule page**. You will see a green "Approved" thumbs-up icon next to the courses that have been approved by your advisor.

- You must be free of all financial obligations.
- You must have completed or be currently enrolled in any prerequisite courses.
