

PHONETIC SPELLING

In order that your name be read properly at the Commencement Ceremony, *it is important* that we know the correct pronunciation. Although the pronunciation of many names is obvious, some require special attention. If your name is one that is pronounced in a special way, please use the sounds like or phonetic spelling in the space provided underneath your name on your commencement name/reader card.

NOTE: It is not necessary to include a sounds like or phonetic spelling unless you are concerned about the way your name will be pronounced at Commencement.

Example:

Leslie Costanzo cō stan zō

Kim Lamagna sounds like "lasagna"

SOUNDS LIKE

A "sounds like" is a familiar word that rhymes with your name
