Requirements

- PA Criminal Background Check (ACT 34)
- Federal Criminal History Records (ACT 114/Fingerprinting)
- Completed Arrest/Conviction Report and Certification Form (ACT 24)

Undergraduate Students, including Transfer Students:

- Completed a minimum of 48 semester credit hours of university-level coursework
- Fulfillment of the Basic Skills requirement as specified by the Pennsylvania Department of Education
- Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- Completion of at least six semester credits in university-level Mathematics, with a minimum grade of C
- Completion of three semester credits in university-level English Composition
- Completion of three semester hours in approved Literature with a minimum grade of C
- Submission of two faculty evaluation forms
- Have met all additional program specific requirements if applicable

Graduate Students: (Graduate students are limited to twelve graduate credits, including any waived courses, prior to completing these requirements)

- Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- Submission of two faculty evaluation forms
- Have met all additional program specific requirements if applicable
