Administered to the Graduating Class of 2013-14

During the Spring 2014 semester, the Exit Interview Survey was sent electronically to 463 students who were expected to graduate at the Undergraduate (UG) level from Holy Family University in May 2014. The following tables are based on the 252 (54%) responses received from UG graduates.
