

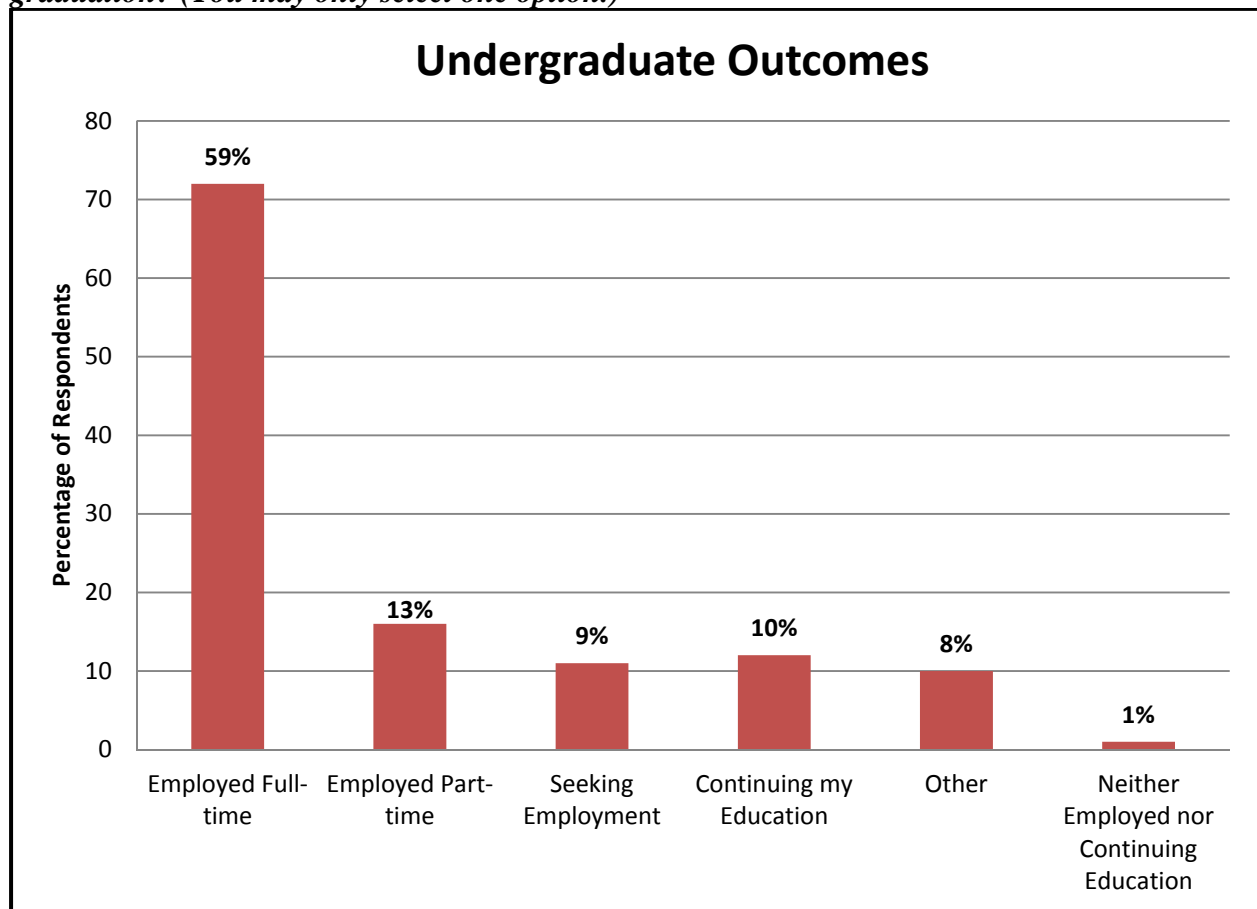
## Holy Family University Post-Graduation Status of Recent Graduates

Based on the Results of the Post-Graduation Survey  
Administered to the Class of Graduates 2012-13

The Post-Graduation Survey was sent electronically to 835 Alumni who graduate from Holy Family University in 2012-13 during the Spring 2014 semester. At the Undergraduate (UG) level, 479 alumni students were contacted and 129 responses were received (27%). At the Graduate (GR) level, 356 alumni students were contacted and 101 responses were received (21%). In total, 230 responses were received for an overall responses rate of 28%.

### Undergraduate Results

*Survey Question: Which of the following BEST describes your PRIMARY status after graduation? (You may only select one option.)*

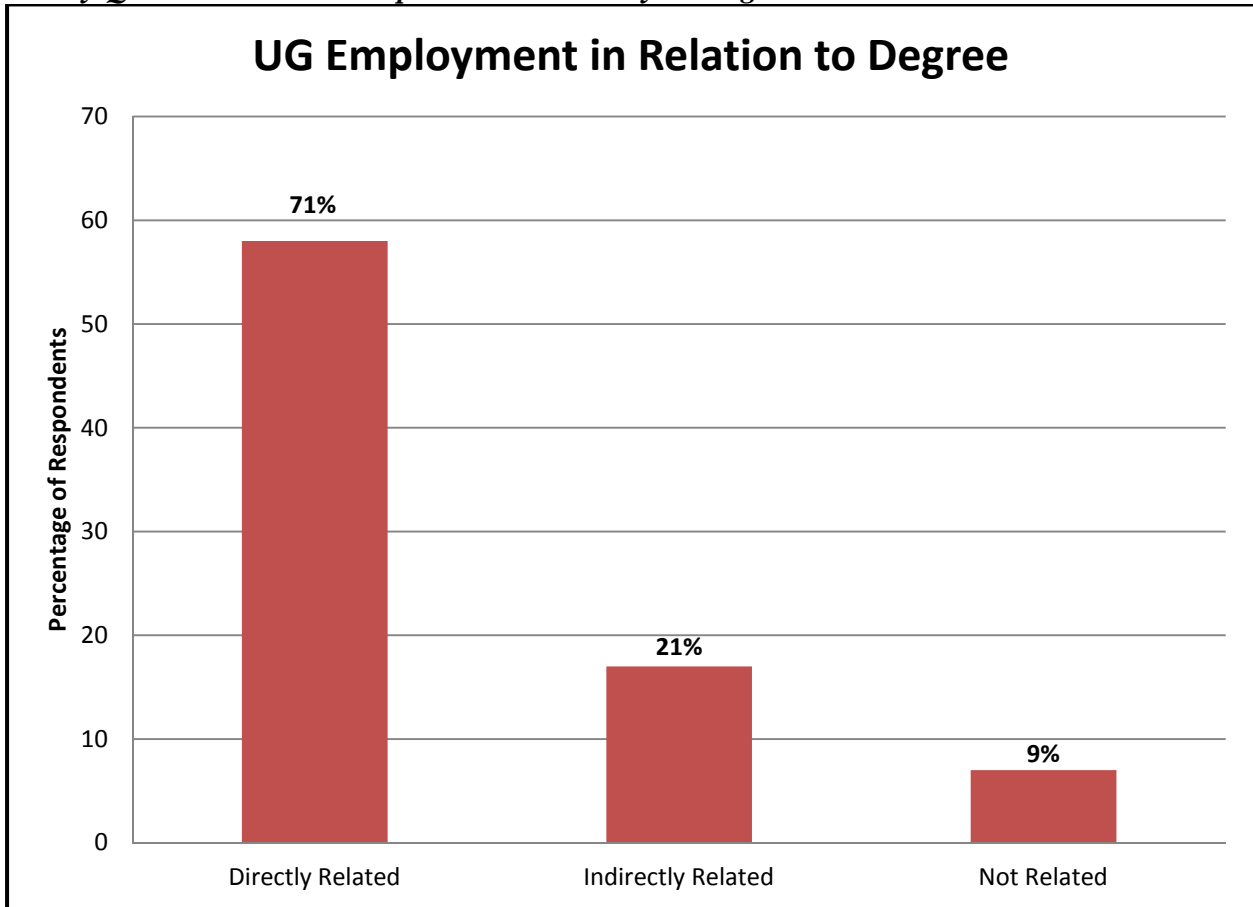


- 88 respondents (or 72%) reported being employed either full-time or part-time.

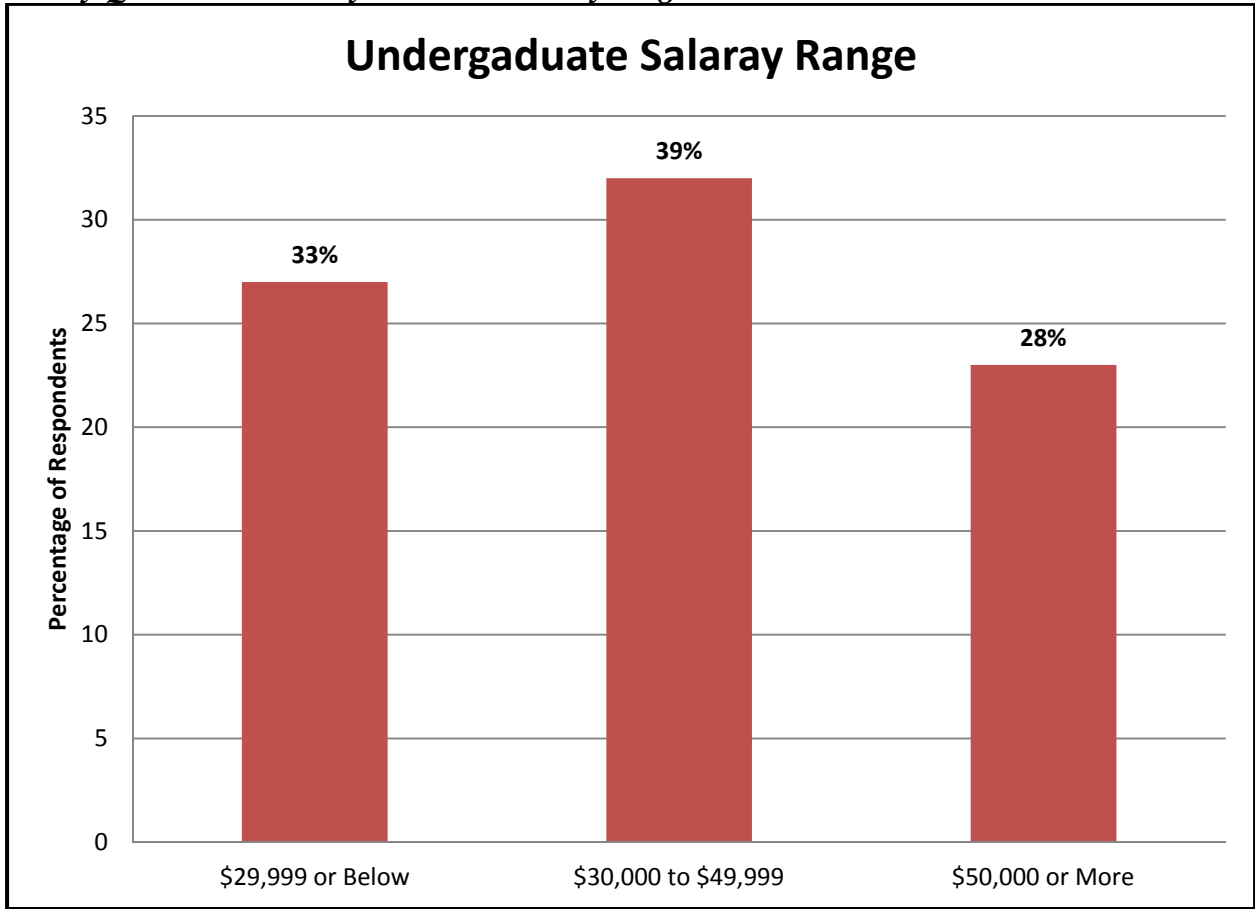
- Of the 12 respondents (10%) who reported continuing their education, only 1 reported doing so at Holy Family University.

*Survey Question: How is this position related to your degree?*



- This question was presented to respondents who reported being employed full-time or part-time as their primary status after graduation (n=88) and 82 or 93% of those respondents provided an answer here.
- Only 7 respondents (9%) reported that their current position was not related to their degree.

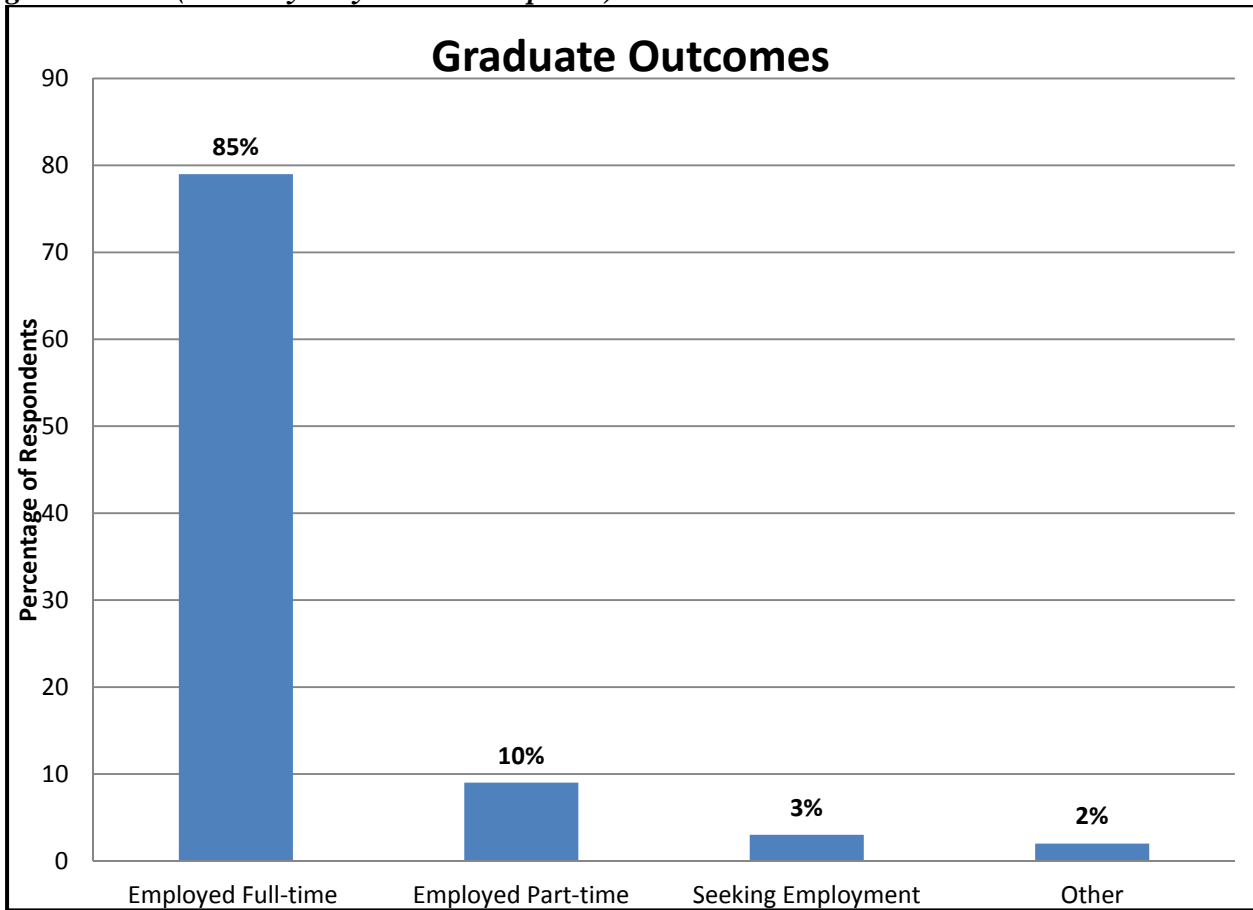
*Survey Question: What is your current salary range?*

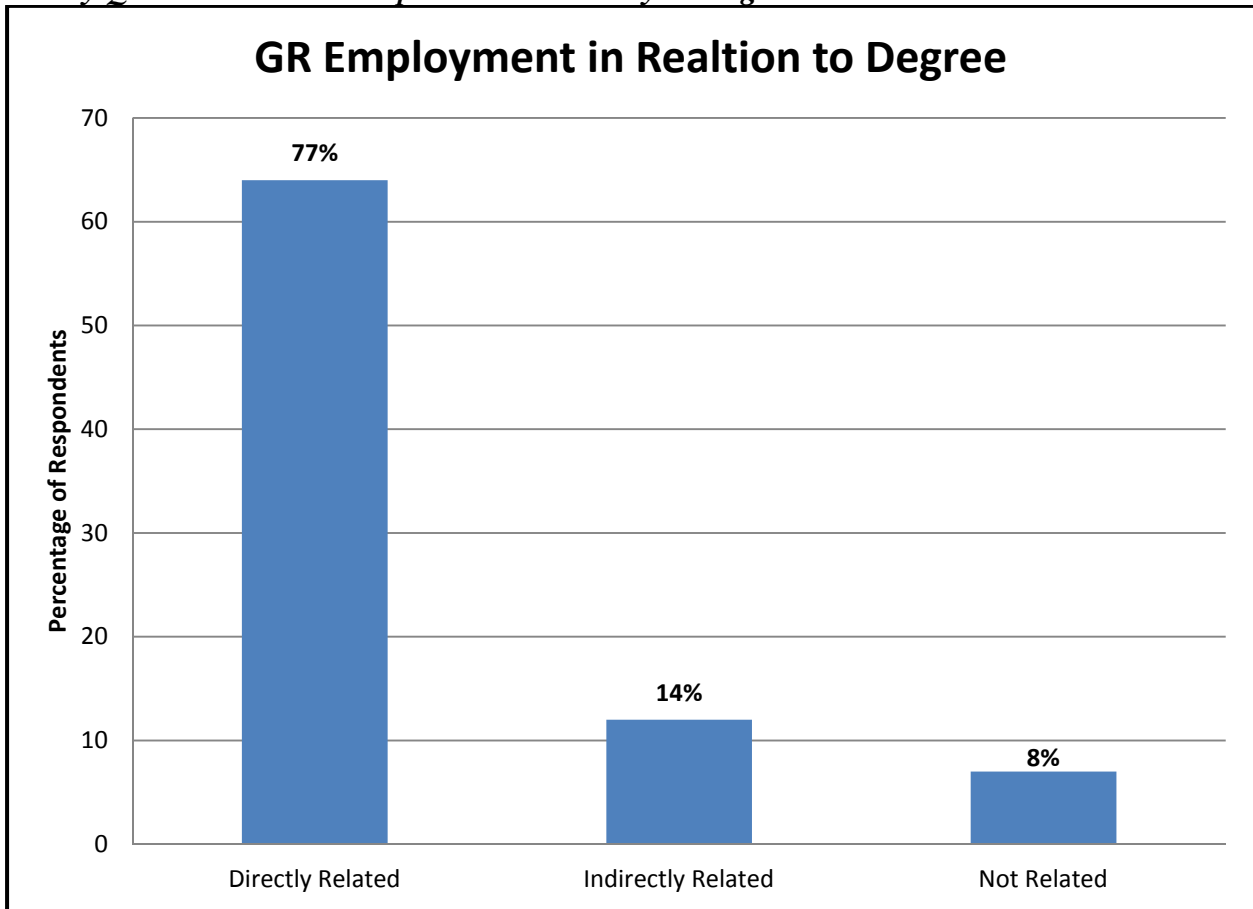
## Graduate Results

*Survey Question: Which of the following BEST describes your PRIMARY status after graduation? (You may only select one option.)*



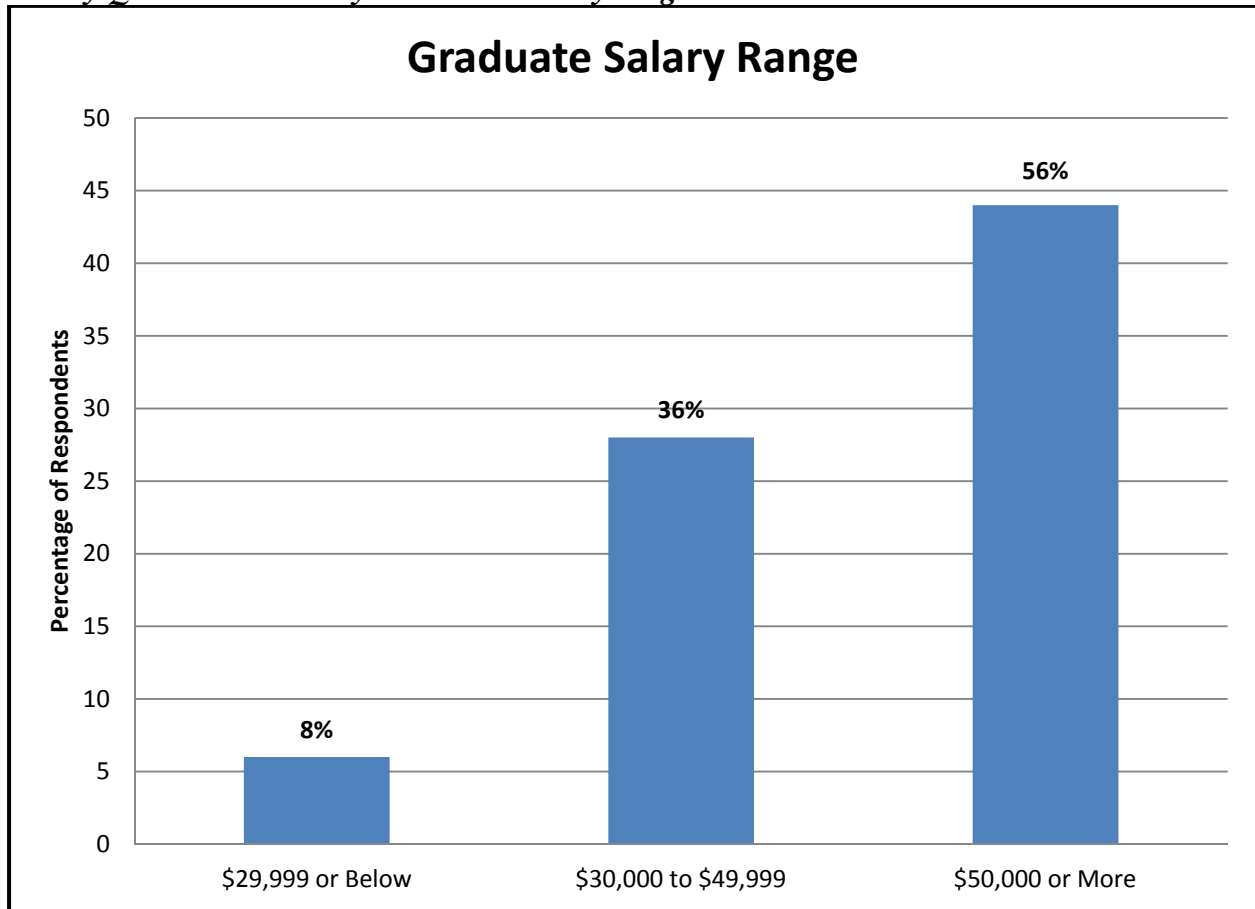
- 88 (95%) of the 93 respondents that provided an answer to this question reported being employed either full-time or part-time.
- No respondents reported further continuing their education after receiving a graduate degree from Holy Family University.

*Survey Question: How is this position related to your degree?*



- This question was presented to respondents who reported being employed full-time or part-time as their primary status after graduation (n=88) and 83 or 94% of those respondents provided an answer here.
- Only 7 respondents (8%) reported that their current position was not related to their degree.
