The Holy Family University School of Nursing and Allied Health Professions is currently seeking reaccreditation for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) and Master of Science in Nursing programs (MSN) through the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). On March 25-27, 2020, representatives from the CCNE will visit Holy Family University to review the BSN and MSN programs.

The Commission provides the opportunity for program constituents to submit, in writing, comments concerning a program's qualifications for accreditation status. Program constituents include healthcare agencies, alumni, faculty teaching in and students enrolled in the BSN and MSN programs.

Comments about the programs should be directed to the CCNE. Written comments are accepted until 21 days before the scheduled visit. Only signed comments are accepted by CCNE. CCNE shares third-party comments with members of the evaluation team prior to the visit, but at no time during the review process are these comments shared with the program.
