Admission Requirements:

- Completed application
- Current résumé
- Official transcripts from all undergraduate and graduate institutions attended
- 250 to 500-word statement of your professional plans & goals
- Two letters of recommendation. One must come from supervisor
- University interview .

Each course is 8 weeks long. There will be 2 face-to-face classes, held in weeks 1 and 5 on a Saturday at our Northeast Philadelphia Campus from 9am to 5pm. All remaining course work is completed online. Courses are designed in a cohort format.
